Maternity Unit

Since 1961, Mount Alvernia Hospital has been committed to delivering quality maternity care for both you and your baby, encompassing antenatal, delivery, postnatal, and paediatric services. Our dedicated team of midwives, nurses, and lactation consultants will provide comprehensive support throughout the birthing process and during postnatal and baby care. Our well-equipped maternity unit includes a delivery suite, maternity wards, baby nurseries, and a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), ensuring a safe and nurturing environment for you and your little one.

Delivery Suite



We take pride in our 15 singlebedded delivery rooms, where each room features central foetal monitoring systems and baby resuscitaires, which are essential for emergencies.

Your baby's safety and your well-being are paramount, so we prioritise close monitoring

and prompt action to address any irregularities.

Our anaesthetic specialists are here to offer epidural service for pain management during labour, ensuring your comfort throughout the process.

In addition, we have dedicated midwives to provide compassionate support to ease your birthing experience and facilitate the natural physiological process of labour.

Maternity Wards Premium Suite and Junior Suite

Integrated with today's lifestyle needs, this ward is designed with soothing colours and a modular wall system that absorbs environmental sounds for you to recuperate in total privacy and comfort. The ample space provided allows the privacy you need to celebrate your baby's arrival with your family and close friends.



All rooms in the maternity wards include in-house educational TV channels dedicated to postnatal mothers.

Premium Single and Standard Single



premium single and standard single rooms are intended for you to have a comfortable and restful stay. pleasant Furnished with themes and cool colours, they create an environment that promotes rest and recovery. Each room comes with a sofa set for your convenience and comfort. If you need a family member or caregiver to stay with you, the sofa can easily be converted into a bed

Double

Each double-bedded room is air-conditioned with shared bathroom facilities and amenities. Each bed has a privacy curtain, side table, telephone, television and a comfortable chair for your visitors.

Nursery



Your baby will be staying in the nursery attached to your maternity ward on the same floor. Our specially trained nurses will care for your baby, while a team of doctors will monitor your baby's health every day.

After breakfast, our nurses will facilitate a bonding session for you and your baby, teaching you how to care for the little one. We encourage you to tap on our nurses' vast baby care experience during your stay at the hospital.

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)

Infants are called neonates in their first 28 days of life and they can be born full term or prematurely (before 37 weeks of gestation). Neonatal care is a specialised field which combines technology and trained nursing professionals to provide special care for the tiniest patients.

The Alvernia Parentcraft Centre (APC) is dedicated to being a comprehensive resource for all your childbirth preparation and infant care needs. Within the APC, you will find a warm and welcoming lobby and a mini library that houses an extensive collection of valuable resources, including parenting guides, books, and reference materials on nursing and breastfeeding.

If you have chosen Mount Alvernia Hospital for the delivery of your baby, we offer educational sessions during your hospital stay, conducted by experienced lactation consultants. Additionally, the APC provides outpatient consultation should you have any questions after your discharge.

The Big Day

Before your estimated delivery date, your obstetric clinic will arrange a maternity booking for you. Our maternity unit will then follow up with a confirmation letter containing your booking and admission details.

We offer various maternity packages for different types of delivery (normal/assisted/ Caesarian section) with a selection of room types (suite/ single/double) for you to choose from.

Please note that we can only confirm the availability of your preferred room type at the time of admission, as patient discharges and emergency admissions may affect room availability. If your desired room is not initially available, we will transfer you as soon as it becomes accessible. All packages include Bacillus

Calmette-Guérin (BCG) and the first Hepatitis B injections for your baby (during the hospital stay only), provided their condition permits it.

Additionally, a personal toiletry pouch containing shampoo, shower gel, body lotion, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, shower cap, and face towel will be provided for your use.

Valuables

For your safety and security, we recommend refraining from bringing excessive cash and valuables to the hospital. Please note that the hospital does not assume liability for personal belongings brought onto the premises.

When to Come to the Hospital

- Your water breaks or you notice continuous leaking of fluid from the vagina;
- · You have vaginal bleeding;
- You experience an onset of persistent, periodic contractions; or
- You notice reduced or no foetal movement.

Confinement Meals



Indulge in our diverse menu options, ranging from confinement food to an array of Chinese, Malay* and Western cuisines. However, do note that your meals might vary from the regular menu if a therapeutic diet is prescribed by your doctor or dietitian.

*No pork or lard is used in the preparation of Malay cuisine.

Breastfeeding-Friendly Environment

During your stay, lactation consultants from Alvernia Parentcraft Centre (APC) will personally visit you at the ward to provide valuable guidance and advice on breastfeeding and general infant care.

You may also join our breastfeeding and baby care workshops during your stay. Held on every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at the APC for one hour, these sessions offer opportunities to practise and enhance your knowledge.

For added convenience, your room features a dedicated TV channel on breastfeeding, guiding you at your own pace.





Essential Protocol

Ensuring sufficient milk intake and preventing dehydration in newborns is crucial during breastfeeding.

We have implemented a newborn dehydration protocol in our nurseries, where we monitor weight loss (ideally within 7-10%) and regular urine output throughout the day. These indicators confirm the correct breastfeeding

techniques and adequate breast milk consumption.

Our goal is to demonstrate the right breastfeeding practices and methods, boosting your confidence and motivation to breastfeed successfully.

Our caring nurses are available to offer guidance and assistance with infant feeding whenever needed.

Going Home



Discharge

Our daily discharge time is 11am (before lunch). Upon confirmation from the doctor, your nurse will hand you the discharge paperwork to make payment at our Business Office located at St Anne Mother & Child Centre, Level 2.

You will also be informed if there is any medication to be collected from the satellite pharmacy. Should you need help to get to the taxi stand, please let our nurses know.

Please make sure that you have the following documents ready to complete your application:

- Personal particulars of the bank account holder and CDA Trustee if they are a third party (i.e. not the child's parent)
- Adoption order and schedule (if your child is adopted)
- Marriage certificate (for overseas marriages)



Newborn Hearing, Bilirubin (Test for Jaundice) and Metabolic Screening Tests



Your nurse may ask if you wish to order these tests for your infant to enable timely intervention.

Postnatal Care

We provide personalised consultation at the Alvernia Parentcraft Centre (APC).

We also conduct baby massage classes and talks on providing optimal nutrition for you and your baby at our special baby seminars held throughout the year.

If you are unable to visit us at APC, we also provide home visits at a fee.

Women's Health Screening

Don't forget to schedule a regular postpartum check with your healthcare provider two to six weeks after your baby's birth. Taking care of yourself is equally vital during this period.

From the Pan Island Expressway (PIE), exit Lornie Road. From the Central Expressway (CTE), exit Braddell Road.

Main Entrance

The main entrance and exit of the hospital are via Thomson Road.

Marymount Road Entrance

Vehicles can enter using the Marymount Road entrance. However, please note there is a height restriction of 2.3 metres.
