Nasal obstruction is a common complaint seen in primary practice, most often due to allergic rhinitis or URTI. The treatment for such patients usually includes some form of antihistamines or decongestants, but are these effective for all patients? This talk will cover the causes of nasal obstruction, recommendations of the current EPOS guidelines (European Position Paper on Rhinosinusitis and Nasal Polyps) 2020, as well as surgical treatment of some of the underlying causes of nasal obstruction.
