Dementia, depression and anxiety disorders are the 3 most common psychiatric conditions among the elderly in Singapore. Because of the multiple comorbidities elderly patients usually have, it is often difficult to know whether a particular symptom, such as lethargy or pain, is caused by one of these psychiatric conditions or due to a coexisting medical illness or both. Patients with chronic medical illness are known to have a high prevalence of comorbid depression and anxiety. This talk touches on some atypical presentations of each of these 3 mental health conditions and how they should be addressed.
