Presentation Outline:

Practising in a busy restructured hospital offered many opportunities for collaboration with other clinical departments. I share my experience in one of these initiatives.

Laparoscopic management of peritoneal dialysis (PD) catheters: The nephrology department practised a “PD first policy” for patients with end-stage renal failure. For patients electing to go on PD, the default method of insertion is by the peritoneoscopic approach, performed by interventional nephrologists. Patients who fail after this initial intervention are referred to urology for diagnostic laparoscopy, adjustment and reinsertion. Patients with risk factors such as previous abdominal surgery or peritonitis are also referred to urology for initial insertion by laparoscopy. The common reasons for PD malfunction include omental wrap, catheter migration, and luminal obstruction. We describe, with the aid of videos, the techniques we employed and developed to tackle these.
