Presentation Outline:

In this webinar, we will discuss the amendments to the Civil Law Act which introduces a codified legal test in Singapore to determine whether a healthcare professional has met the standard of care for the provision of advice. This new statutory test will replace the 3-stage common law test for a doctor's duty to advise, laid down by the Court of Appeal in *Hii Chii Kok v Ooi Peng Jin London Lucien* and another [2017] SGCA 38 (also known as the Modified Montgomery test). This new statutory test is based on peer professional opinion.

The key elements of the new statutory test will be explored together with its implications for clinicians, and there will also be a discussion with the seminar participants using a case study to apply the legal principles of the new statutory test. There will also be a Q&A segment.

(**Note:** This is a second run of the seminar done by the speakers for the local doctors this year. It was previously conducted as a CME webinar in July 2021.)
