Robotic technology marks a paradigm shift in Colorectal surgery. The 3D stereoscopic views coupled with increased precision in the narrow pelvis is a game changer. Studies have confirmed improvements in patient outcomes, making this an accepted modality of treatment in many advanced nations.

Having completed a double Ministry of Health (MOH) sponsored fellowship in Minimally-Invasive Colorectal Cancer and Pelvic Floor Surgery, Dr Wong has applied this technology in the management of patients with both malignant and benign disease, ranging from Rectal cancer to Constipation.

Patient selection and individualization of treatment is key to optimizing patient outcomes, where achieving a good quality of life for benign conditions like constipation, can often be more challenging than cancer surgery.
