

National Electronic Health Record Phase IA Go-Live

Mount Alvernia Hospital will start contributing data to the National Electronic Health Record (NEHR) on 23rd December 2025.

NEHR refers to Singapore's National Electronic Health Record, a system that receives patients' key health information from all healthcare settings to uniquely present the information accessible by registered healthcare practitioners. The initiative is mandated by the Ministry of Health (MOH) through the Health Information Bill for all licensed healthcare providers.

With our contribution to NEHR, medical professionals with access will have a better view of a patient's health information from treatment in our hospital. This enables greater collaboration and informed clinical decisions to enhance patient safety and follow-up treatments. It also reduces duplicated tests, lowers the risk of medication errors and ensures more consistent and coordinated patient management. Patients will be able to access their own health information through Health Hub.
